

YOUR GUIDE TO breeder microchip registration

identibase® 

identibase provides free microchip registration transfer from dog breeders to new keepers. Breeders, no matter how big or small, will need to register on identibase as a breeder.

To help with the registration process we've provided a step-by-step guide:

STEP ONE

Breeder creates an online breeder account. It's easy to set up and free of charge. Just visit www.identibase.co.uk/breeder/register

STEP TWO

Breeder books an appointment to microchip the litter with a vet or qualified microchip implanter.

STEP THREE

Vet or qualified implanter microchips the litter, ensuring the breeder is aware of the unique microchip number for each puppy.

STEP FOUR

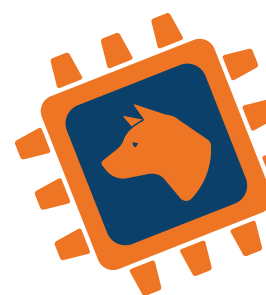
Breeder logs into identibase and clicks 'New Registration' to start the process of registering each of the puppies in the litter.

STEP FIVE

When the breeder is ready to hand over the puppy to its new keeper he or she logs into their identibase breeder account, clicks 'rehome' and enters the new keeper's details. It is recommended this is done with the new keeper present to prevent errors. Please provide an email address for the new keeper as this is the fastest way to confirm new keeper registration and it enables identibase to help straightaway with the reuniting process if required.

STEP SIX

New keeper receives an email to confirm they're the new registered keeper along with a copy of the microchip certificate. If no email address is provided, a certificate will be sent by post.
